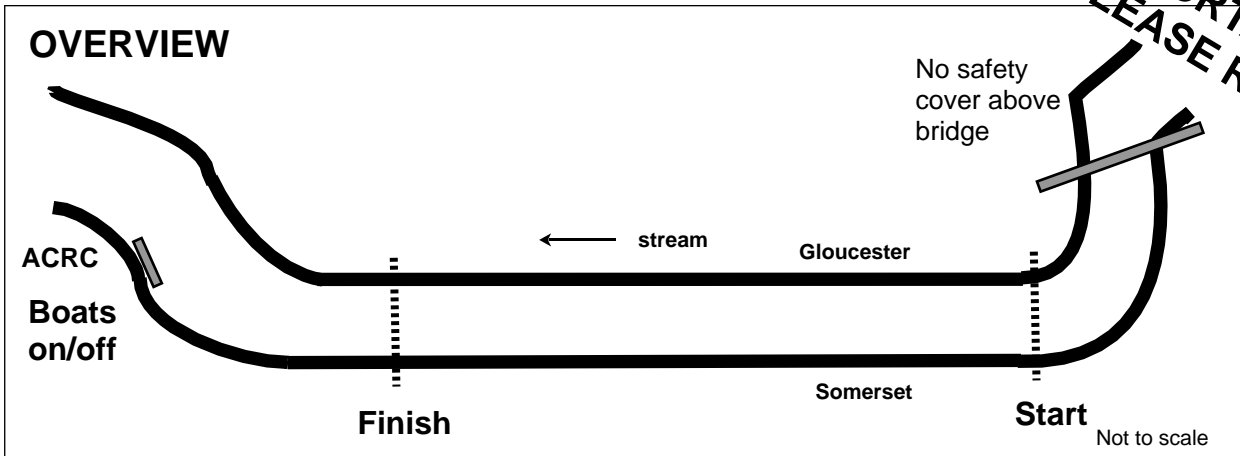


# BRISTOL AVON REGATTA AT SALTFORD - 17 MAY 2008

## CIRCULATION PATTERN - WATER

**IMPORTANT - PLEASE READ**

Wait here until called to proceed up course in convoy

Boats will be sent up the course in batches. Racing will be stopped while the convoy proceeds upstream. Each batch will contain about 12 boats.

The Draw specifies the order in which crews must boat and the boating time. Make sure you take your boat to the launch rafts in the order specified and at the required time.

This is very important for the efficient running of the regatta.

### MARSHALLING

Bridge

Turn here and line up in race order

Gloucester

Lower number

Higher number

Somerset

Boats will proceed up the course in race order. While going up the course boats must not stop or overtake, and must keep up with the boat ahead.

All boats should proceed past the stake boats and turn and line up in race order (so the first two boats in the convoy turn first etc). Listen carefully for marshal's instructions.

The first two boats should get on their stake boat as soon as they have turned.

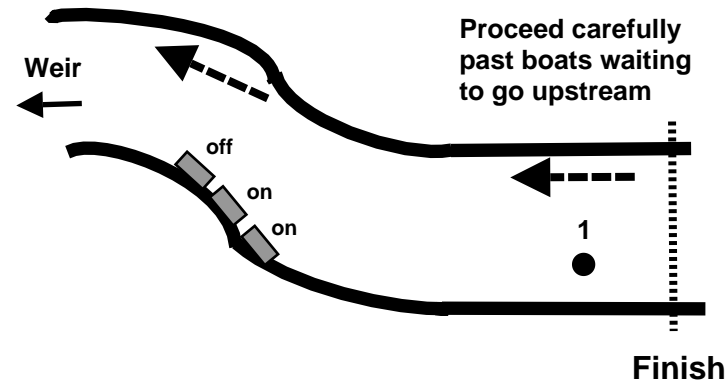

The course is straight. There is no stagger.

Two umpires' boats are moored on the course and there is another boat below the finish. Watch out for these.

## AFTER RACE



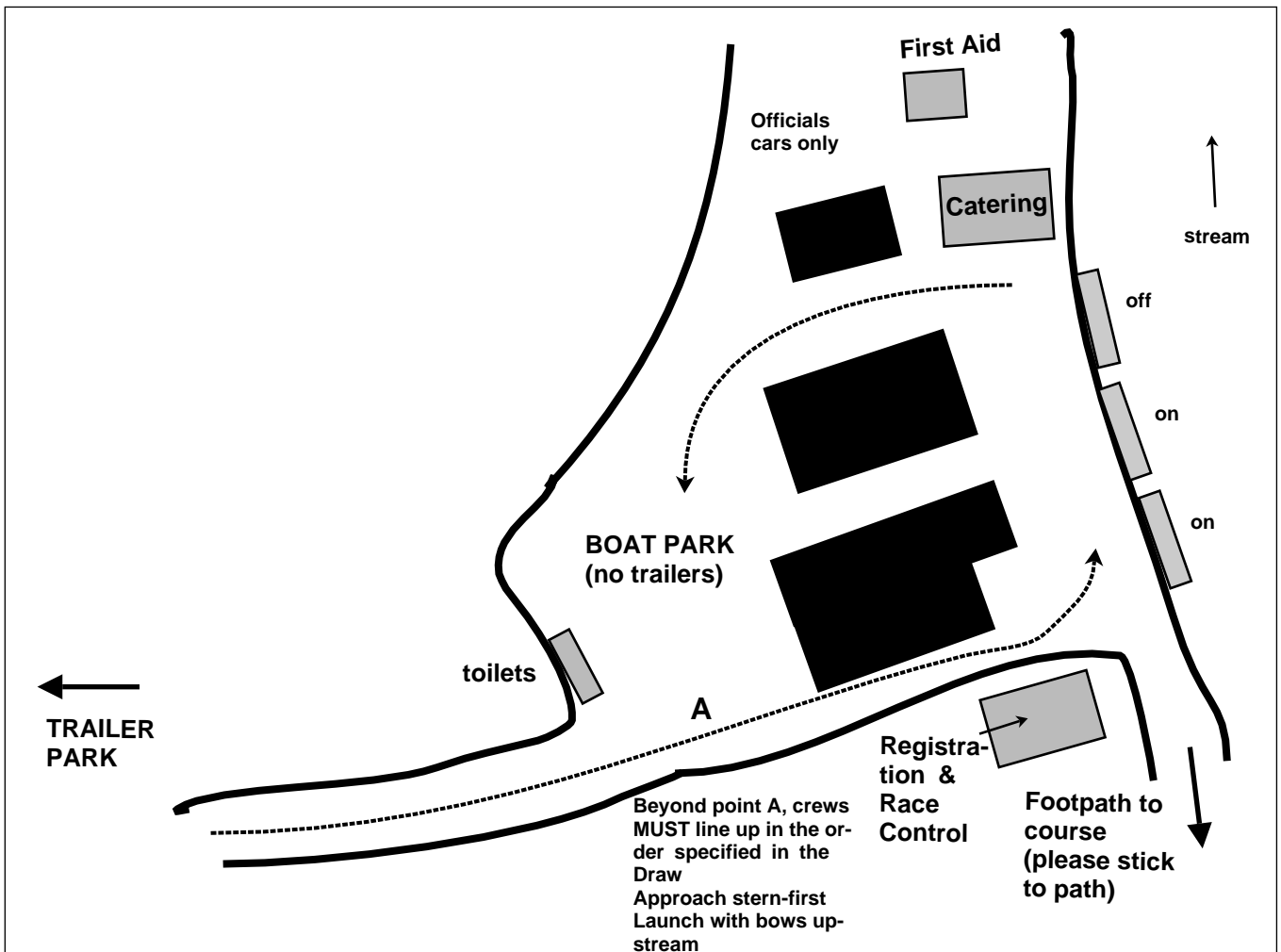

After your race, proceed downstream on the far side. Take care as you pass the boats waiting to go upstream.

Carry on past the rafts and listen carefully for marshal's instructions. When instructed, turn and proceed to the "off" raft.

A little further downstream there is a weir. Make sure you turn well upstream of it.

## CIRCULATION PATTERN - LAND



**The Regatta Timetable specifies the order in which crews must boat and the boating time. Please find your opposition and make sure you line up at point A in the order specified and in good time for your boating time. This is important for the efficient running of the regatta.**

After your race, if you have another round in the same session you may leave your boat on your trestles in the Boat Park. All other boats must be returned to the trailer park.

Please make sure a channel is left through the Boat Park for emergency vehicles.
